Who she is

Multiple award-winning storyteller, author, actor, and workshop presenter, Bernadette Nason, hails from England, lives in Austin, and performs worldwide. She's been a touring artist with the Texas Commission on the Arts since 2002, telling stories annually to as many as 30,000, both students & adults.

Nason became committed to storytelling when she saw that TV, video games and technology were hindering the growth of our own storytelling skills, and that many parents had stopped telling stories at bedtime. "It's vital to preserve the art of live storytelling, encouraging everyone, especially kids, to tell stories themselves."

Nason is a company member of Austin Playhouse, ONSTAGE Theatre Co. and Pollyanna Theatre Co. She belongs to the Screen Actors' Guild and Actors' Equity. She's often seen in regional theatre and movies (check out *Miss Congeniality*) and uses her performance skills in all her work.

Nason presents at festivals, conferences, libraries, schools, theatres, museums, senior centres, clubs, camps, stores, and parties of all kinds for all ages.



The Programs

What she does

Nason's programs are comprised of multicultural tales and personal stories brought to life with facial expressions, distinct character voices, vibrant humor, and astonishing energy. She encourages audience participation, especially for youngsters, and always stresses the joys of reading. With older students, this often develops into lively discussions on favorite books and careers in the Arts. All ages delight in her Q&A and "show and tell."

Nason prepares new stories each season so as to offer variety and diversity, and maintain a fresh repertoire. Programs support standardized school testing and are available for all annual occasions: Thanksgiving, Christmas, Hanukkah, Easter, Chinese New Year, Black History Month, St. Patrick's Day, Halloween, Cinco de Mayo.

For cultural and social studies, Nason has selections from all over the world: Greek Myths, Tales from Merry England, African Delights, Irish Yarns, and many more. She'll entertain with rabbits, snakes and dingoes; giants, ogres, dragons; fairies, princesses, enchanted ponies. Stories can be made suitable for all ages, but programs designed specifically for "grown-ups" are available.

How to get her to do it

Bernadette's calendar fills up 6-12 months in advance. If you need particulars about a visit or wish to book, contact information is set out below (email is best). Go to www.bernadettenason.com for further information, or to request a press packet.

- ◆ Audience size: anything from 5 to 5,000 (depending on location)
- ◆ Performances: 40 minutes (flexible). Several shows are usually performed in one visit. All-day, multiple-day, and multiple-school visits are the norm.
